## Parent Support and Volunteering

Every year we have been impressed at how many of our parents help out in some way and do their fair share. Using these parents as inspiration, we are taking a new approach to organizing volunteers called Fair Share Volunteering, encouraging everyone to do what they can to be involved.

There are many different opportunities for you to simultaneously see your student excel, and to support his/her needs in the Blanchard Band program. We have our busy Fall filled with football games, parades, and contests, and our Spring consisting of concerts, more parades, performances, concert competitions, and the Band Banquet. A band of this caliber requires a tremendous amount of parental support. We need each family to be involved in supporting the program. Please examine the list below, choose a first and second choice from the committees to participate in, and fill out and return the Fair Share Volunteer form at the back of this packet. As a committee member you will not be expected to attend every event overseen by your committee. The coordinating Committee Chair or Band Booster Executive Board will call upon you to help at various times throughout the year depending on what you list as your strengths. We ask for two choices to make sure we get help where it is needed from people who feel comfortable helping in that area.

- Fundraising Committee: This committee will coordinate and execute our fundraisers. On the table so far is selling a spice kit before Christmas, a Silpada party (sterling silver jewelry), and August $26^{\text {th }}$ kicks off our full band brochure fundraiser which is selling pizza and cookie dough.
- Marching Band Committee: This committee coordinates band social events, helps with equipment set-up/tear down during performances, organizes tailgating before home football games, provides water in the stands at all football games, helps load and unload the trailers at events, and staffs uniform checkout day. This committee is primarily busy in the fall, and there are a few parades in the spring.
